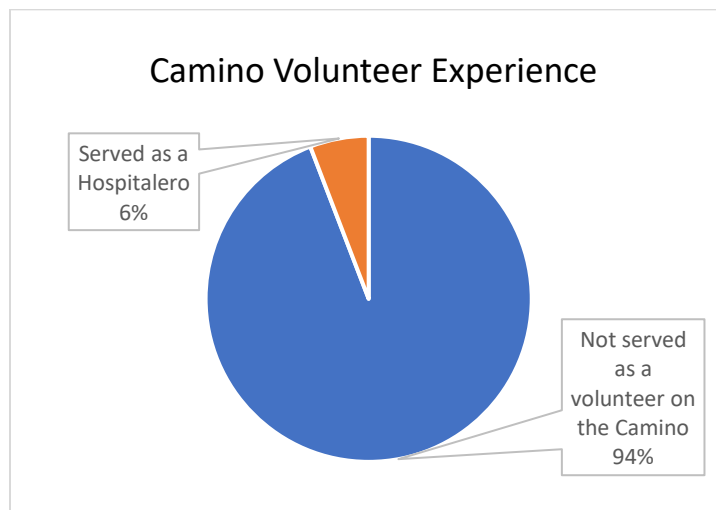
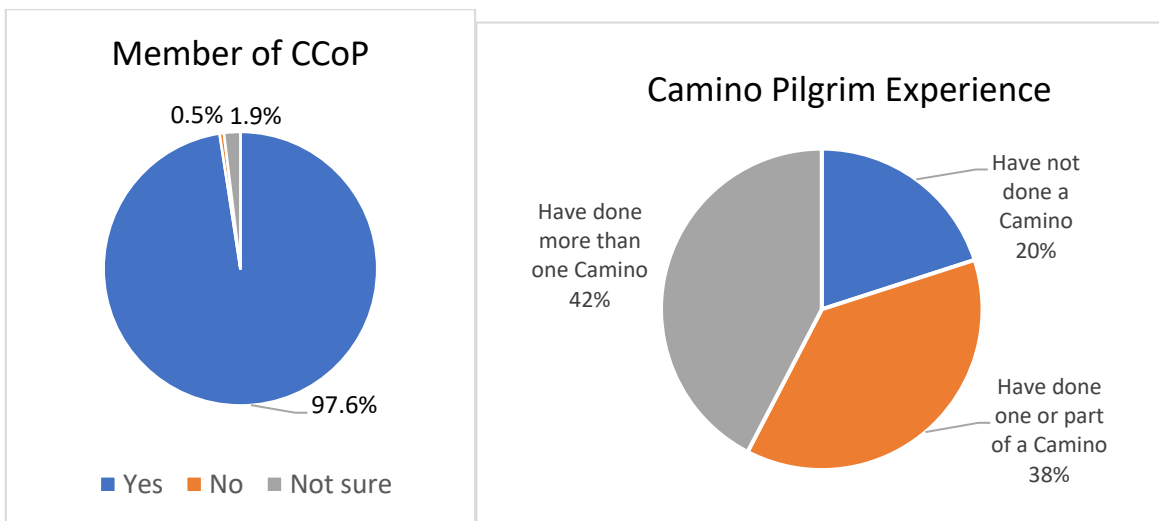


2021 Survey of Subscribers about their Camino plans

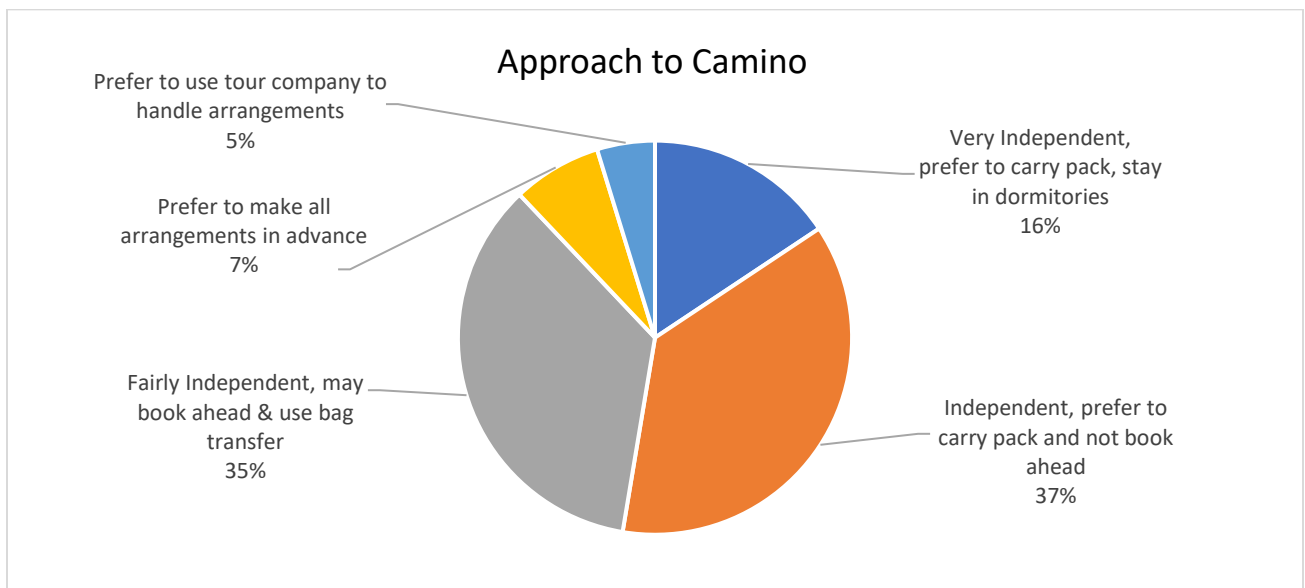
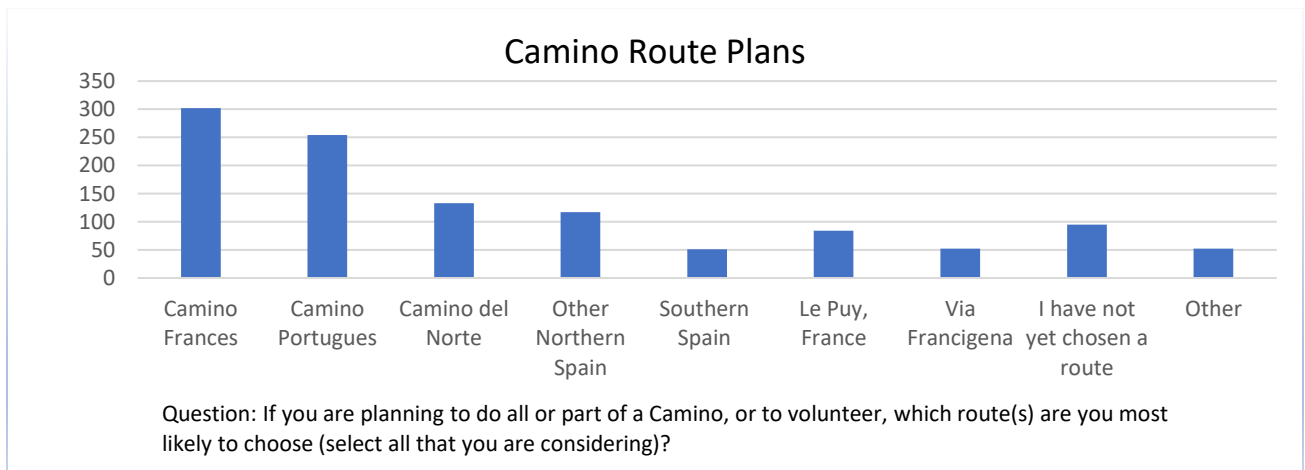
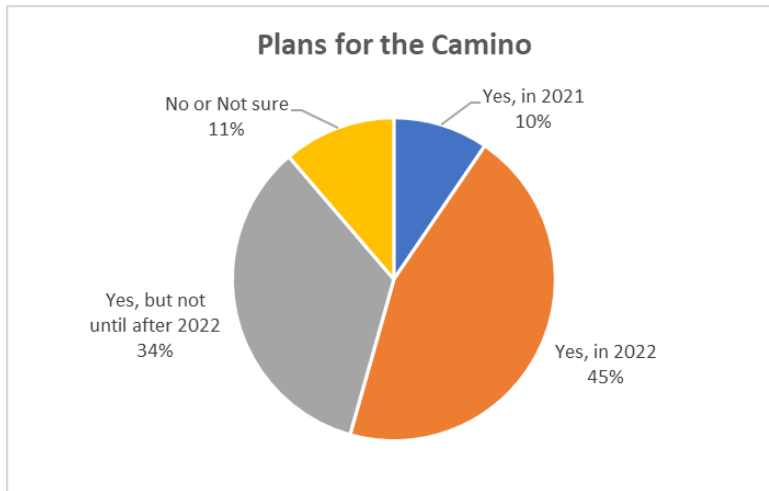
The results of our (second annual) COVID survey of our subscribers are out! We asked Canadian pilgrims to let us know about their plans for walking the Camino.

Almost forty percent (38.4%) of the subscribers to our national mailing list (779 out of 2028 recipients) responded to our survey (compared with 27% who responded to last year's survey). The survey was open from August 8-21. The results help us to understand our members' and subscribers' intentions concerning when, where and how they hope to walk their next Camino, and what they will need in order to do so.

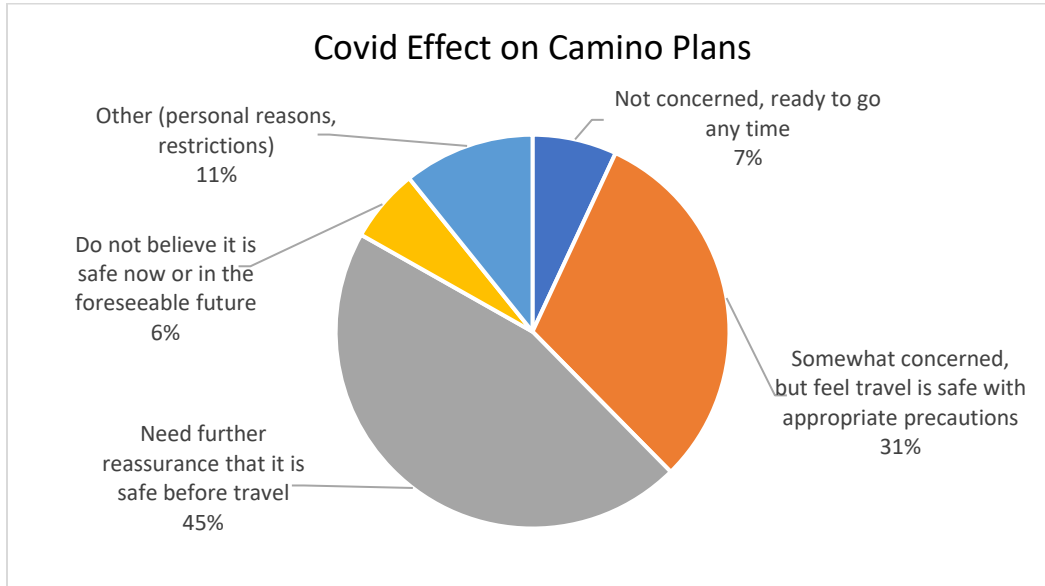
